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SCHEDULE - I

General Terms & Conditions for tender submission & supply

Gwalior Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Mydt, Gwalior (GSDSM), an ISO certified cooperative organization, invites online tenders from bonafide manufacturers and/ or their authorised dealers for supply of milk premix present in the GAIN/ UNICEF/ WFP/FSSAI list of premix supplier for fortification of staple food items for supply of vitamin A and D2 premix for fortification of milk under MPCDF milk fortification program in Madhya Pradesh, strictly in adherence to the detailed specifications given in the schedule II of the tender documents.

SCOPE OF WORK:-

Micronutrient malnutrition in India is a serious public health issue affecting population at large, impacting physical and mental growth. Fortification of staple foods like milk offers a promising opportunity to deliver micronutrient rich foods to larger population and is found to be a solution to combat various deficiency diseases. Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) has fast tracked initiatives to raise awareness and encourage the adoption of fortified food amongst both producers and consumers.

ELIGIBILITY / PREQUALIFICATION CONDITIONS.

- Bidder shall be a supplier of milk premix present in the GAIN/UNICEF/WFP/FSSAI list of premix suppliers.
- Bid should not be submitted for the product/products for which the concern supplier/company stands blacklisted/banned/debarred by any State/Central Govt. or its any agencies procurement on the ground of conviction by court of law or the products being found spurious and adulterated.
- The concern supplier/company whose product has been declared as of spurious or adulterated quality and any criminal case is filed and pending in any court shall not be eligible to participate for that particular product, in the Bid. Similarly convicted firm/company shall also not be eligible to participate in the Bid.
- The Vitamin A and D2 Premix will be procured from the registered suppliers as per the eligibility criteria.

TENDER SUBMISSION:

- 1.1. Tenders received by e-mail will not be considered.

- 1.2. The tenderer(s) should clearly state in their offer the address, telephone, fax, e-mail, PAN and GST Numbers. Any change in the address should immediately be communicated to the Chief Executive Officer, Gwalior Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Mydt, Gwalior and correspondence thereafter will be made at the changed address.
- 1.3. Negligence on the part of tenderer in filling the tender form offers him/her no right to withdraw the tender after it has been opened
- 1.4. The acceptance of the tender and award of the purchase order will be the sole right of the Chief Executive Officer, Gwalior Sah. Dugdha Sangh Mydt. who does not bind himself to accept a tender in whole or in part or reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reasons and no explanation can be demanded of the cause of rejection of the tender by any tenderer.
- 1.5. The Chief Executive Officer, GSDSM reserves the right to place order for whole requirement with any tenderer or split the orders among one or more tenderers or not to purchase at all any item even after rate approval.
- 1.6. Each tender should be accompanied with copy of PAN, income tax clearance certificate, sales tax number and sales tax clearance certificate; without which the tender may not be entertained.
- 1.7. The tenderers should submit the rates online only. The conditional tenders are liable to be rejected.
- 1.8. No person or firm is permitted to submit more than one tender under different names.
- 1.9. The tenderer shall not sublet the contract or assign to any other party or parties, the whole or any portion of the contract without prior written permission of Chief Executive Officer, GSDSM.
- 1.10. Manufacturers will be given preference. Copy of license is to be attached with tender for each item filled in, wholesalers dealing with the item will have to attach copy of authorization certificate of the manufacturer.
- 1.11. Tenderer shall fill all the details of the unit in the enclosed form- A, B in schedule-III. (To be uploaded –mandatory.)
- 1.12. **EMD instrument must be received before opening of tender.**

Bid Validity

Bid shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening.

Price indicated on the price schedule shall be inclusive of Pkg & frdg & freight. GST (to be shown extra)

2.0. Earnest Money Deposit

- 2.1. All the tenderers are required to deposit Earnest Money as specified in Schedule II of the tender document only online . Submissions of earnest money by any other mode than specified above shall not be acceptable and the related tender shall not be eligible for consideration.
- 2.2. Any tender which is not accompanied by Earnest Money deposit are liable to be rejected. Earnest money deposit of tenderers will be returned within 90 days from the date of opening of the tender. The earnest money deposit of the successful tenderers will be released on completion of supply/work as the case may be within the stipulated period.
- 2.3. No interest will be paid on the earnest money for the period during which (the EMD) lies in deposit with Gwalior Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Maryadit.
 - EMD may be forfeited :
 - If successful Bidder/supplier fails/denies to perform work
 - If any bidder/supplier withdraw its bid during the bid validity period
- 2.4. Security Amount Will be deposited Rs. 500000.00 for supply of Flavoured Powder and Rs. 100000.00 for Vitamin AD Premix before award of Contract.

3.0 PRICES:

- 3.1. Prices offered by the tenderers should be firm and free from all escalations and shall be valid at least for a period of 12 months from the date of approval of rates on mutual consent validity period may be increased maximum for 02 Years. We would communicate our rate approval within 60 days of opening of tender.
- 3.2. The tenderer should quote rate on FOR dairy plant Banmore basis.

- 3.3. The tender should clearly specify whether rates quoted are exclusive of GST.
- 3.4. If need be, negotiations will be done for prices and as well as terms & conditions of material supply only with the party which offers the lowest rate.

4.0 MODE OF DESPATCH

- 4.1 The material to be supplied by successful firm shall be dispatched to the dairy under prior intimation. Depending upon the type of material, the supplier shall have to carry out proper packing/crating to avoid damage during transit.
- 4.2 Wharfage /Demurrage etc. on account of incorrect or delayed dispatch of material/documents shall be the responsibility of supplier and shall be recovered from the bills.

5.0 LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

- 5.1 Delivery date are fixed for supply of material they shall be strictly adhered too. In case they are not followed, or in case of delay in execution or non-execution of the order, the Dugdha Sangh reserves the right either to cancel the order and make alternative purchases from other sources, at the risk and cost & expenses of the defaulting supplier. In case the supplies are not affected as per the schedules, the liquidated damages may be charged on the goods not so delivered as under:-

Sl.No.	Duration of delay	Liquidated Damages
1.	Upto 15 days	1% cost of the unit.
2.	Between 16 to 30 days	2% cost of the unit
3.	Beyond 30 days	Upto 5% cost of the unit.

- 5.2 If the tenderer fails to make supply as per purchase order without any valid reason, the order would be treated as cancelled and the firm may be blacklisted for future dealings and EMD also would be forfeited by the management.

6.0 INSURANCE

Insurance is to be arranged by the tenderer.

6.1. DOCUMENTS TO BE FURNISHED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION.

- (A) Manufacturing Units should have proper valid license by the concerned authority for manufacturing/processing and storing of premix-Copy of which will have to be furnished. The legible and certified copies of the following documents must be attached /annexed to Technical Supporting Documents.
- (B) Valid Manufacturing license & Product Permission (as the case may be). For imported products Valid Importing License &Product Permission of manufacturer (as the case may be).
- (C) Valid GMP/FSSC/FSSAI certificate of manufacturer for manufacturing Milk Premix.
- (D) Valid I.S.I. certificate (if applicable)

7.0. **INSPECTION**

- 7.1. All the supplies are subject to inspection at our plant before acceptance. If goods are rejected due to defective or wrong supply, the report of our authorized official in this respect shall be FINAL and no correspondence on the subject would be entertained. The rejected goods should be removed from our premises by the tenderer within 15 days after receipt of our inspection report failing which the same shall be returned to the supplier at his risk and expenses or disposed off in Auction and the proceeds, if any, less expenses would be credited to tenderer's account.
- 7.2. Sample of the articles should be sent/produced before the competent authority if asked for within 7 days or as mutually agreed.

8.0 **PAYMENT**

Our normal terms of payment is full payment after receipt, inspection and acceptance of materials in our stores within a period of about 30 days after receipt. Such payments shall be made through RTGS.

9.0 **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:**

If any act of commission or omission of a unit under contract brings Gwalior Sah. Dugdh Sangh Mydt. to dispute, then Gwalior Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Mydt. shall be competent to debar/blacklist the unit from further business.

10.0 **CONSEQUENCES OF BREACH OF AGREEMENT:**

If any firm under the contract commits breach of any of the conditions, it shall be lawful for the Chief Executive Officer, Gwalior Sahakari Dugdha Sangh Mydt. to cancel the contract and to purchase material from any other alternate sources on the risk and cost of the defaulting unit.

11.0 **DISPUTE ARBITRATION & FINAL AUTHORITY:**

- 11.1. It should be clearly understood that in the event of a successful tenderer failing to accept and execute the supply order, then decision of the Chief Executive Officer, Gwalior Dugdh Sangh Mydt., in this respect will be final and binding on the successful tenderer
- 11.2. For all matters of dispute, the decision of the Honourable Chairman, Gwalior Sah. Dugdha Sangh Mydt. Under Arbitration and Conciliation Act. 1996 shall be final and binding on all the concerned.
- 11.3. For all disputes, the venue for legal course shall be at Gwalior.
