1. Tenders are invited for the Supply of Profile sheet
2. The Tender are requested to go through the tender document's instructions and various terms and conditions contained in Annexure-I to II. It may be noted that no conditions or stipulations to the contrary or which are inconsistent will be accepted. Tender are requested to ensure that all such schedules along with questionnaire (duly filled-in), are submitted along with their offer. The Tender should also note that in absence of any of the schedules, their offer is like to be rejected.
3. All the details to be filled Sealed as per tender document format and tender should read all instructions for compliance before submitting his tender.
4. **The tender to be submitted in two parts as explained below:-**
 - (a) **Envelop-A** : This part is fulfilling the requirement of deposit towards Earnest Money and Technical Bid (Form-A) along with duly filled questionnaire. The supplier in this envelope should put both original money receipt in support of having deposited cash with JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR towards Earnest Money OR the Bank Draft for the purpose and Technical Bid as per tender document (duly filled) and documents supporting the same. Original EMD instrument to be submitted in envelope On or before tender opening date.
 - (b) **Envelop-B** : - Sealed Envelope for this part shall contain duly filled Price Bid (Form-B) as per Sealed tender document.

TECHNICAL SCOPE OF SUPPLY & SPECIFICATION

SPECIFICATIONS

The specification for the entire scope of supply under the order shall be in accordance with the latest IS & AS codes . wherever these codes are silent, the same shall be governed by sound engineering practice, and the decision of the jsds, in matter of interpretin, shall be final and binding on the contractor .

The bidder must read carefully all such specification / codes before submitting their bid. It shall be deemed that the bidder has thoroughly read & understoof the "scope of work & technical specifications" before filling in the rates / prices, irrespective of the fact whether they have really done so or not, and no claim on this account shall be entertained at a late date.

1.0 SCOPE OF SUPPLY

The work mainly consists of supply of pre-coated Galvalume steel skeets with roofing & cladding accesspries to jsds jabalpur.

1.1 Precoted ZINC ALUMINIUM SHEET ROOFING/CLADDING

2.1.1 Material

The base metal of the roofing shall be cold rooled steel sheet conforming to IS: 513. It shall be zinc aluminum coated by hot-dip process as per AS :1397/IS:277/IS:14246, the bottom unexposed surface shall then be coated with alkyd backer of minimum 5 microns coat a primer. Top exposed surface shall have primer of minimum 5 microns follwed by SMP/suoer polyester top coat of minimum 20 mixrons of specified colour.

Manufactures of pre-xoated sheets may be of the following:

2.1.2 Properties

The pre-coated zinc aluminium steel sheets meet the following performance standard.

2.1.3 Profile

The profile shall have a depth of not less than 28mm (with intermediate ribs). Overall total coated thickness shall be minimum 0.50mm having base metal thickness of 0.45mm. minimum weight (supply width) shall be 5.00kg/SqM.

3. All the final inspected materials should be packed properly for transportation, loading / unloading and storage purpose min.for one year .packing & forwarding cost shall be including with offer.
4. **Hi-tensile pre-painted Zinalume/Galvalume steel sheets :-** supply & Fixing of pre-painted coloured trapezoidal profiled sheeting 1000-1020 mm cover width, 28-30 mm high crests with subtle square fluting in the five pan at nominal 190-255 mm (as approved by EIC) centre-to-centre manufactured out of 0.50 mm TCT hi-tensile pre-painted zinalume / Galvalume steel (AZ-150 gsm.aluminium – Zinc alloy metallic coating of total both sides 550 Mpa yield stress as per AS-1397).colour/Exterior coat of SMP (silicon modified polyester) / BHP XRW paint system, 20 micron top coat applied over 5 micron primer and a 5 micron polyester back coat applied over 5 microns primer or equivalent coating / painting. The sheet shall have wide pans with stiffening ribs for effective water shedding and special male/female ends with full returns legs on side laps for purlin support . The male end of the sheet shall have anti-capillary flute at side laps to prevent leakages . the sheet shall be fixed by means of Galvanised self – tapping fasteners (12-14x55 with EPDM seals). The sheet shall be supplied in lengths maximum upto 6-12 meter long to suit site dimensions.
 - A) The bidder may consider cliplock system instead of self-drilling screw system without any changes in specification,rates terms and conditions of the work.
 - B) 0.50 mm thick TCT (total coated thickness) /0.45 BMT(base metal thickness) precoated sheet of make “tata bluescope” , “lloyad” , interarch or equivalent confirming with minimum tensile strength 550 Mpa confirming AS : 1397. THE sheet should pass 1000 hour salt test as per relevant test.

5. **supply of pre-painted coloured** trapezoidal profile / plain /curved & profiled sheeting in ridges,gutter,gutter pipe, curved surface, north light curve, louver,cornors,apron piece etc. manufactured out of 0.50 mm TCT hi-tensile pre-painted zincalume / galvalume steel (AZ-150 gsm.aluminium –zinc alloy metallic coating of total both sides 550 Mpa yied stress as per AS-1397).colour / exterior coat of smp (silicon modified polyester) / BHP XRW Pint system, 20 micron top coat applied over 5 micron primer and a micron polyester back coat applied over 5 micron primer or equivalent coating / painting. The sheet shall be fixed by means of galvanised self-drilling self-tapping fasteners(12-14x55 with EPDM seals).the sheet shall be supplied in lengths maximum upto 6-12 mtrs long to duit site dimensions.

(acrylic polyurethane finish paint; eil spec.code) two coats, each 35 micron (total dft 270 micron on average) including scraping/cleaning old surface and surface preparation by brass chipping / wire brush / emery paper / whipping by dry/wet cloth or combination of above to the entire satisfacation of EIC.(30% of plan area for roof will be measurd for payment purpose.)

6. Any other requirment which is not coverd in the scope of supply but necessary to complete the supply and work are to be complied by the bidder with the coated rates.
7. Bidder may visit the site of works before quoting his rates / prices for correct assessment of work.
8. Length of the sheets & roofing accessories should be 1.5m,2.0m, 3.0m, 4.0m, 5.0m, 6.0m or as per direction of jsds . however , bidder may assess the app . Qty of all sizes by visiting the site before submitting thew offer.
9. Colour of the sheets shall be finalized by jsds.bidder has to supply the materials exactly as per colour suggested by jsds.

Party has to supply the materials in quantity as per order. However, quantities of different sizes may be varying as per requirement of jsds.

Terms & Conditions

1. BASIC QUALIFICATION OF TENDERER

This tender is open for Registered and reputed manufacturer/Authorized suppliers/Channel partners who provide satisfactory evidence:-

(ii) Preference will be given to Indian manufacturer so that stage wise inspection of Equipment can be offered to check the quality of product.

2. EARNEST MONEY

The supplier shall deposit the Earnest Money amount (EMD) of amount Rs. 10,000/-for Profile Sheet payable either in cash at Finance section SDS or in the form of Demand Draft in favour of " Jabalpur Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Maryadit ,Jabalpur" . In case, the supplier withdraws his offer during the validity period, after placement of order, the EMD amount shall be forfeited.

RETURN OF EARNEST MONEY TO TENDERER

EMD shall be returned to the un-successful Tenderer, as soon as possible, after the tender is decided and on execution of agreement with successful tenderer. No interest shall be paid on EMD amounts.

3. TAXES AND DUTIES

a) All taxes and duties should be included in the prices quoted. Any kind of taxes and duties shall not be paid extra. However, the breakup of taxes & duties must be indicated separately.

4. AMENDMENT IN SPECIFICATIONS

The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. may revise or amend the specification prior to the date notified for opening of Bid of tender. Such revision/ amendment, if any, will be communicated to all those who have bought the tender documents from our office and also uploaded on our web site www.mpcdf.gov.in

5. DELAYED/ LATE SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. shall not assume any responsibility for any postal delays either for the late receipt of documents by supplier or late receipt of tenders by the Board/JSDS. No Extension in time shall be granted on such grounds.

6. ALTERNATIVE TENDERS

Tender should be submitted as per intent of tender documents; any alternative offers are liable for rejection.

7. MISTAKES IN TENDERS

Rates should be quoted in both; figures and words. In case of ambiguity between rates in figures and words, lower of the two/beneficial to the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR shall be considered. Such offers can also be rejected on recommendation of committee.

8. Documents to be submitted with the Tender (Mandatory)

- a) Copy of Registration Certificate of the Firm / Organization (Tenderer).
- b) Copies of purchase orders last five year .
- c) Copy to latest Income Tax returns & copy of Permanent Account Number (PAN) or GSTno.
- d) Clint list
- e) Completion/Performance certificates
- f) Income Tax/Sales Tax return of last two years

9. ALTERATIONS/CORRECTIONS IN TENDERS

Any alteration/correction in the tender document should be counter-signed. Further, no post tender alteration/correction shall be entertained.

10. INCOMPLETE TENDERSTender which is incomplete or obscure in any form is liable for rejection.

11. ACCEPTANCE OF PART/WHOLE TENDERS & NEGOTIATION OVER TENDERERS RIGHTS THEREOF

- (A) Chief Executive Officer, Jabalpur Sahakari. Dugdha Sangh Mydt, The Power To Negotiate With Lowest tenderer On The Tender Date Or Any Suitable Date Decided Thereof.
- (B) JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR-. reserves the right to accept/ reject wholly or partly any tender without assigning any reason whatsoever. The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR-. in this regard shall not entertain any correspondence.

12. AMBIGUITIES IN CONDITIONS OF TENDERS

In case of ambiguous or self-contradictory terms/conditions mentioned in the tender, interpretation as may be advantageous to the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR shall be taken without any reference to the tender.

13. DIS-QUALIFICATION OF TENDERS

Tender which gets opened before the due date as a result of improper or no indication having been given on the cover to indicate that it is a tender, will be disqualified. Tenderer will not be permitted to change the substance of his tender on post interpretation/improper understanding grounds. This includes post tender price changes/ modifications etc. after opening of Price Bid. In such events, otherwise, that is, when a supplier does not comply, tender will be rejected.

14. DEVIATIONS FROM TERMS & CONDITIONS Offers with deviations in the terms of payment, liquidated damages, EMD and performance guarantee are liable to be rejected out rightly.

15. SUBMISSION OF TENDERS

The tender shall be submitted in two(2) parts:- Part-I shall contain "EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT" & " TECHNICAL BID". Marked as Envelop-A Part-II shall contain "PRICE BID", in the Price Schedule. The supplier shall ensure that the prices/rates are filled in accordance with the Performa for "Price and Quantity." Marked as Envelop-B

16. It may please be noted that the due date/ time of opening can be altered, extended, if felt necessary by the purchaser, without assigning any reason thereof However, due intimation shall be communicated in such a case.

17. OPENING OF E.M.D. & TECHNICAL BID

Mandatory documents to be submitted as per S.No.8 above shall be part of Technical Bid. The concerned tender committee of JSDS shall first open the Part —I envelope -A of all the Tenderer and verify the Earnest Money Deposit and Technical Bid submitted by the Tenderer. Committee shall check for the validity of Earnest Money Deposit as required. In case, the requirements are incomplete in EMD and Technical Bid other envelope-B of Price Bid of the concerned Tenderer shall not be opened. The requirement for EMD and Technical Bid shall be verified and thereafter, the second part, i.e. Price Bid submitted by the Tenderer shall be opened on the same date in respect of eligible Tenderer.

18. VALIDITY OF TENDERS

The offers shall be valid for 90 days. Validity of the offer shall be counted from the date of opening of tenders. Those who do not agree for a validity of 90 days will do so at their own risk and their offers are liable to be rejected.

19. AUTHORISATION/LOCAL REPRESENTATIVE

Only authorized representative, possessing necessary authority letter from the supplier who have participated in the tender shall be allowed to attend the tender opening.

20. ACCEPTANCE OF TENDER

- i) The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR-. may reject any or all tenders or to accept any tender considering advantageous to JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR-. Whether it is the lowest offer or not.
- ii) The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. may split the quantities against the tender on more than one supplier for the same item. The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR-.shall assign no reasons for this and the same will be binding on the Tenderer.

21. PAYMENT TERMS:-

Payment shall be made by A/c payee Cheque or RTGS only. The Schedule of Payment shall be as follows: a) 75% against the safe receipt of material at site b) 25 % after installation ,Commissioning and successful trial run of supplied equipment.

22. PRICES AND STATUTORY LEVIES

- (i) The tenderer should quote price F.O.R. destination:-
 - (a) Unit Ex-works/Ex-go down rate including packing and forwarding.
 - (b) Excise Duty applicable on Ex-works price as on date of Tender.
 - (c) Tax : GST
 - (d) Freight charges
 - (e) Any other levy/taxes.
 - (f) In case of exemption from excise duty/or sales tax, documentary evidence shall be furnished with the offer.
 - (h) No revision on any account shall be allowed during execution of the order.
- (ii) Prices offered by the tenderer should be firm and free from all escalations. The prices offered should be valid at least for a period of 90 days from the date of tender opening. Rate approval shall be communicated within 30 days from the date of tender opening.
- (iii) The Material to be supplied shall be dispatched to site by Road transport under intimation to the purchaser and consignee. Depending upon the type of material, the supplier shall have to carry out proper packing/crating to avoid damage/breakage during transit. Road permit for dispatch of material if required will be sent by JSDS on written request from supplier.
- (iv) After rate approval, the party shall have to execute an agreement on a non—judicial stamp paper worth Rs. 100/- to be executed with Jabalpur Sahakari Dugdh Sangha Maryadit , Jabalpur.

23. TRANSIT RISK

(a) Responsibility regarding covering of risks during transit of material shall entirely be on the supplier. The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT,JABALPUR-. shall, in any case, not bear the transit risks/ transit insurance charges.

(b) Insurance shall be arranged by the supplier.

- 24. DELIVERY:**Supply should within one months from the date of receipt and acceptance confirmation of order or from the date of contract agreement whichever is applicable. In case of any delay due to assembling or any other technical reasons, supplier will have to communicate in advance in written to the CEO,Jabalpur Sahakari Dugdh Sangha Maryadit ,Jabalpur.

25. FORCE MAJEURE

Force majeure condition is herein defined as:-

- (a) Natural phenomena, such as floods, draughts, earth-quakes and epidemics.
- (b) Act of any Government Authority, domestic or foreign, such as war, quarantines, embargoes, licensing control or production or distribution restrictions.
- (c) Accident and disruptions such as fires, explosions, increase in power cut with respect to date of tender opening, break-down of essential machinery or equipments etc.
- (d) Strikes slow down, lockouts continuing for more than three (3) weeks.
- (e) Failure or delay in the supplier's source of supply due to force majeure causes enumerated at (a) to (d) above, provided the supplier produces documentary evidence to show that there were no other alternative sources of supply available to him or if available, the lead time required was likely to be longer than the duration of the Force Majeure at the normal source of supply.
- (f) Any cause which is beyond the reasonable control of the supplier or purchaser as the case may be. All the provisions of this clause shall apply whether the disrupting cause is total or partial in its effect upon the ability of the supplier to perform.

26. The original bills should be forwarded to the paying authority and should be marked "ORIGINAL". The bill should indicate Sales Tax Registration Number and date allotted to him under Sales Tax Act. 28. The invoice in triplicate with relevant documents such as Material Receipt in good condition etc. should be submitted to JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR

27. PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

- 27.1 If during the course of 18 months subsequent to the date of receipt of consignment or 12 months from the date of commissioning whichever is earlier (wherever applicable) any of the goods found to be defective in materials or workmanship or develops defects during service, they will have to be replaced by the supplier, free of all charges. All necessary arrangements on these accounts will be made by the supplier.**
- 27.2 The said material if required to be replaced, shall be collected by the supplier/ firm from Area Stores/ work site at their own cost and at their own responsibility. These materials will like-wise be returned duly repaired/ replaced and tested subsequently by the supplier to the destination indicated on "FREIGHT PAID BASIS" at their cost in a reasonable time of 30 days from the date of intimation. The guarantee period as stipulated in clause 32.1 above shall also be applicable for repaired/replaced material, which shall however be counted afresh from the date of its delivery in our stores/site.
- 27.3 Further, it is clarified that all the charges towards supply of fabrication materials including packing, forwarding, loading, unloading shall be borne by the supplier. The amount deposited under security deposit clause shall also cover the performance guarantee of the material.

- 27.4 Actual cost of dismantling and replacement of these materials with the new ones may be charged to the supplier's account. 34.5 To and fro transportation cost of such failed equipment may also be borne by the supplier/ supplier.
- 27.5 In the event of the supplier's inability to adhere to the aforesaid provisions, suitable penal action will be taken, which may include blacklisting of the firm for future business with the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. for a certain period.

28. EXTENSION ORDER

The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. Reserves right to place an extension order for any additional quantity to the extent of 100% quantity of the original order on the same rates, terms and conditions within six months from the date of order.

29. RECOVERIES FOR LIABILITIES AGAINST OTHER CONTRACTS

All amount recoverable from the successful Tenderer against earlier contracts including orders on sister concern with the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. will be adjusted from payment due against the contract that may be awarded under this specification.

30. COMPLIANCE OF REGULATIONS

The supplier should execute and deliver such documents, as may be needed, by the purchaser in evidence of compliance. All laws, Rules and Regulations are required to be incorporated in this reference. Any liability arising out of contravention of any of the laws shall be the sole responsibility of the supplier and the purchaser shall not be responsible in any manner whatsoever.

31. CANCELLATION OF ORDER

- 31.1 The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. May upon written notice of default, terminate contract in the circumstances detailed hereunder:-
- a) If in the opinion of the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR, the supplier fails to deliver the material within the time specified or during the period for which extension has been granted by the JSDS.
 - b) If in the opinion of the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR, the supplier fails to comply with any of the other provisions of this contract or material is found not in accordance with prescribed specifications and or the approved samples.
 - c) As a result of stage inspection, if applicable, it is revealed that material and/ or, workmanship is substandard which is likely to affect the performance of the finished product, a notice would be served' by the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-. to the supplier to suspend further activities and to take urgent steps towards corrective measures, failing which the entire order would be cancelled.

31.2 In the event of such termination, JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR shall exercise its discretionary power as :-a) To recover from the supplier the agreed liquidated damages. OR b) To purchase from elsewhere after giving due notice to the supplier on account and at the risk of the supplier such stores/ material not so delivered or others of similar description in respect of consignment not yet delivered. OR c) To cancel the contract reserving JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-'s right to recover damages.

31.3 Notwithstanding that the powers under clause (a, b & c) referred to above, are in addition to the rights and remedy available to the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR under the general law of India relating to Contract.

31.4 In the event of risk purchase of stores of similar description, the opinion of the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR shall be final. In the event of action taken under clause 39.2(a) or (b) above, the supplier shall be liable to pay for any loss, which the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR- may sustain on that account but the supplier shall not be entitled to any saving on such purchases made against the default. 33.5 The decision of the Chairman, JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR- shall be final regarding the acceptability of the stores supplied by supplier and the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR- shall not be required to give any reason in writing or otherwise at any time for the rejection of the stores/ material. 39.6 In the event, JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR- does not terminate the order as provided in clauses above, the supplier shall continue execution of order, in which case he shall be liable to the JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR-.

32. ARBITRATION

In case of any dispute, if arises between the parties relating to any terms and conditions of the Tender / Agreement and or regarding the agreement /tender before or after the filling of tender and /or execution of the agreement, any party may refer the dispute to a sole arbitrator who will be the Chairman of Jabalpur Sahakari Dugdh Sangha Maryadit, Jabalpur or a person nominated by him whose decision and award shall be final and binding to both the parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be under and accordarice with provision of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. Supplies under the Contract shall be continued by the supplier during the arbitration proceedings, unless otherwise, directed in writing by the Purchaser or unless the matter is such that the work cannot possibly be continued until the decision of the arbitrators or of the Umpire, as the case may be, is issued.

33. JURISDICTION

Any dispute or difference, arising under, out of, or in connection with this tender/ contract order shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of competent court at Jabalpur only.

34. RANDOM TESTING-

Inspection of material after receipt or waiver of inspection will not relieve the supplier from his responsibility to supply the material strictly in accordance with the specification. The JABALPUR SAHAKARI DUGDH SANGHA MARYADIT, JABALPUR In case, the samples fail to withstand the required test, the entire lot will be liable to be rejected (i.e. unused material so supplied) and the supplier will have to refund the amount paid, including all taxes and duties, as well as the test charges thereof, after inspection. Such quantities or rejected material as identified, shall be removed by the supplier and replaced in full at his own cost.

35. CORRESPONDANCE:-

Copies of all important correspondence on subject should be sent to "CEO, Jabalpur Sahakari Dugdh Sangh Maryadit, Jabalpur".

36. CONSEQUENCES OF BREACH OF AGREEMENT

If the authorized person of the unit or a partner in the contract/tendering firm commit breach of any of the conditions of agreement it shall be lawful for the Chief Executive Officer, Jabalpur Sahakari. Dugdha Sangh Mydt, to cancel the contract and purchase or authorize to purchase stores at the risk and costs of the unit.

37.0 DISPUTE ARBITRATION & FINAL AUTHORITY

37.1 It should be clearly understood that in the event of any dispute between supplier and purchaser due to deviation from any terms and conditions of work order & contract agreement, the decision of the Chairman, Jabalpur Sahakari Dugdha Sangh Mydt., in this respect will be final and binding on the both supplier and purchaser.

37.2 For matters of dispute, relating to the interpretation of the above clause, the decision of the Chief Executive Officer, Jabalpur Sah. Dugdha Sangh Mydt, shall be final and binding on all the concerned.

38. Liquidated damages

If the supplier fails to deliver any or all of the Goods or perform the Services within the time period(s) specified in the contract, the purchaser shall, with out prejudice to its other remedies under the contract, deduct from the contract price, as liquidated damages, a sum equivalent to: i) Upto 15 days 1% of the contracted value ii) Between 16 to 30 days 2% of the contracted value iii) Beyond 30 days 5 % of the contracted value JSDS reserves the rights to either to cancel the order and make alternative purchase from other sources at the risk and cost of the of defaulting supplier.
